Childcare and Dinner Money Debt

Please be aware that the Governing Body has approved two new policies to address debts associated with dinner money and childcare. These can be found on the website, so please make sure you read them if you access either of these services.

Dinner money should be paid **in advance** on **Mondays**. Amounts paid after this will not be counted until the following week, so please ensure you pay on time.

Childcare money should be paid one month **in advance**, according to the contract.
