Learning Journeys

We use an electronic system to record children's Learning Journeys while they are at Hadfield Nursery School.

We ask for your e-mail address on starting Nursery as we send your child's Learning Journey

by e-mail at the end of each term. You will receive an initial e-mail from '2BuildaProfile Hadfield Nursery School' and you need to click on the link to activate the system.



Each learning Journey is made up of photographs of your child engaged in learning activities, with some



notes made by the observer. It is a lovely way to see what activities your child is engaging with at Nursery and the learning they are taking from them.

We are pleased that you can now contribute to your child's electronic Learning Journey too. All you have to do is e-mail your observation to:

The e-mail address you send this from must correspond with the e-mail we contact you on at the end of each term with the Learning Journey.

Your Key Worker will get a message that you have an observation to add and your information will be included in the next Learning Journey sent home.

Progress Summaries

We use an electronic profiling system devised by Classroom Monitor. This links with the Learning Journey system, so any observations we make are linked to the profile. We also regularly update each profile so we can keep track of each child's development.



We are pleased to say that parents/carers can now access a summary of their child's profile at the end of each term.

You will receive a welcome e-mail from Classroom Monitor before the end of term. This will include your password and a link to click which will take you to your child's progress summary. Instructions are given in the welcome message.

Please note that this on-line progress summary is a series of statements, linked to the Early Years Foundation Stage. The system has some links to Learning Journey evidence and links to learning resources which you may find helpful.

Frequently Asked Questions:

What is the difference between a Learning Journey and a Progress Summary?

- Our electronic Learning Journeys are observations of your child's learning, usually with a picture and some notes on the learning we have observed. This assessment informs our future planning.
- A Progress Summary is a summary of your child's development at that point in time.

Can I add my own observations to my child's Learning Journey?

- Yes please! We welcome your contributions as you spend far more time with your child than we do and they will do things at home that we may not see.

What observations can I add to my child's Learning Journey?

- Anything you feel is important! We love to hear about children's particular interests and fascinations from home.
- For example you can upload a photograph of your child pedalling a bike and add a few words that this is the first time she has done this at home.
- Or you could send a photo showing your child's interest in a spider on its web in the garden.

What if I don't have an e-mail address?

- We can help you set up an e-mail address for you to use. Our IT technician, Alan, is available most Wednesdays.
- If you prefer to have a paper copy, then ask your Key Worker or Mrs Mortimer to arrange this.
