Ensure children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding make good progress in all areas of learning, including in the Characteristics of Effective Learning and levels of Well-being and Involvement.

Children's social and emotional well-being is supported through interventions and 1-1 support. (Measured through data tracking and scales of well-being and involvement)

IMPACT

- The Headteacher is responsible for the overall support of the following vulnerable groups: Pupil Premium, English as an additional language, 2YO, rising 3s, Children in Care & adopted children, and monitors their progress regularly.
- Children in receipt of EYPP are supported by the SENTA. Each child has their progress monitored termly to set targets (Headteacher and their key worker/SENTA). All staff are aware of the PP children and endeavour to involve them in sustained shared thinking experiences whenever possible.
- Nearly all Pupil Premium children have high (53%) or medium (42%) levels of Well-Being with just one child with a low level of involvements (a child with additional needs to barriers to attendance)
- Nearly all Pupil Premium children have high (42%) or medium (53%) levels of involvement, with just 1 child (5%) with a low level of involvement
